Trends and Issues

We are still seeing a huge number of jobs - at least 55 in-house solicitor jobs have been introduced since July by my count.

Companies are having to wait longer and longer to find the right people - in some cases we see roles readvertised directly 4 or 5 times before they are filled (or indeed given up on!) and this causes (1) candidates to question the strength of the roles and (2) boredom to set in when they keep seeing the same company looking to recruit lawyers.

We are often asked why more candidates are not applying to jobs, and I think we can say that in-house solicitors are being looked after well at the moment for the most part - with hybrid working, solid salary and bonus packages, and manageable workloads being standard. Some in-house lawyers are moving to law firms (where they are also looking after their people very well), and there simply isn't a flood of junior to senior legal counsel in the market now.

Clients should usually expect 2 or 3 applicants for a good opportunity rather than a handful of candidates and might not find their perfect fit unless they are prepared to wait. Quick fixes can be to offer hybrid/remote working to suit the needs of the candidate and/or a much higher basic salary (to tempt solicitors away from the riches of top tier private practice). If you are not offering at least hybrid working and responding at least in part to the salary bump out there, it's going to be difficult for you to recruit. Oh, and you need to recruit speedily to avoid the competition.
